We are continually seeking ways to advance our school to serve our families. A typical family has many demands on their time with schedules, family activities, work, church, driving in heavy traffic, etc. TADS online school management was implemented to save parents time by integrating admissions, enrollment, billing, financial aid and records.

It is with excitement that as we open re-enrollment for the 2017-2018 school year, we announce a new continuous enrollment process. Continuous enrollment means that once a student is enrolled, enrollment automatically renews each year until your student graduates from St. Paul. Re-enrollment is assumed unless the family notifies the school by January 18 that they choose not to re-enroll. Continuous enrollment will save you time and reduce paperwork while creating a more seamless process.

To summarize what this means: Beginning in January 2017 you will not need to log into TADS to complete the re-enrollment process. You do not need to do anything.

Should you have questions or concerns about re-enrolling, please contact the school office by January 18.

The nonrefundable enrollment fee has not changed. It is \$150 for the first child and \$50 for each additional sibling. We will communicate tuition rates to you in early January after school board approval.
